

Rongotea Store Sale Wednesday 30th June 2010

Wednesday's sale saw a smallish offering of cattle yarded but a good bench of buyers were present. 2-year steers sold from \$915-\$1080 (\$1.84-\$1.87) with lighter framed steers selling for \$575 (\$1.57). Empty Dairy heifers sold at \$452-\$550 (\$1.31-\$1.61) with 2-year bulls selling at \$510-\$700 (\$1.56-\$1.87). 2 very nice lines of Yearling Friesian bulls sold for \$595-\$640 (\$2.07) with other lines making \$490 (\$1.84). Yearling-15month steers sold for \$345-\$420 (\$1.58-\$1.70). Yearling heifers were making \$460-\$475 (\$2.02-\$2.18). Weaner Jersey bulls were \$400 (\$2.28) with other lines of weaner bulls selling at \$285-\$425 (\$1.63-\$2.99). Weaner heifers, \$275-\$340 (\$2.70-\$2.75) with steers \$380-\$430 (\$1.84-\$2.23). the heavy lines of boner cows sold well making \$700-\$895 with medium framed cows \$595-\$640 and lighter sorts \$340-\$430 (\$.96-\$1.36)

Only a small number of feeder calves yarded this week with Friesian bulls making \$100-\$140 and Hereford x bulls \$152. Friesian heifers unrecorded, \$20.

There were a good offering of lambs entered this week with the heavy lines selling for \$103.50. various other lines of lambs made between \$54-\$80 with lighter sorts \$32-\$54.

In pig saddle back sows were \$135-\$150 with sows \$175. Choppers made \$130 and weaner pigs sold at \$65-\$85.
